

Overview

St. Benedict Catholic School is a multi-age school from Preschool through Grade 8 with students from diverse and varied backgrounds.

Our Preschool has two different programs---5 mornings per week for 4 year olds and 3 afternoons (M-W-F) for 3 and 4 year olds.

Our Kindergarten students come everyday all day.

We have a teaching assistant who is shared among the primary classes. Our classes from Kdg. through grade 5 are self-contained. All teachers are fully certified by the State of Ohio for the grade levels and subjects that they teach.

St. Benedict Catholic School has a Middle School (Grades 6-8) and our students move from room to room for different subjects.

ALL students share the experience of time with specialists in ART, MUSIC, COMPUTER, SPANISH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION.

St. Benedict Catholic School offers a library with a librarian assisting the students and provides Book Fair events. A celebration of Right to Read Week is also held each year with different events throughout the week.

St. Benedict Catholic School has a part-time hot lunch program. Our students eat in the lunchroom and have available to them a wonderfully equipped playground facility.

St. Benedict Catholic School students attend liturgy weekly and that have an active part in preparing and participating in these liturgies.

St. Benedict Catholic School also offers an Extended Day program for students who are registered in grades Preschool through grade 8. Students attend on an as needed basis and are billed separately at \$2.50 per hour each week. Students may be in the building beginning at 7:00 and after school Extended Day program lasts until 6:00 PM.
